What is Student Council?

- Purpose: A way to get actively involved in the workings of their school and hone their leadership skills
- Outreach events: Frighting Hunger (Haunted House for elementary school children), Polar Bear Plunge, District Council Conferences
- In-school events: Winter Ball, Flight Night (a cooler version of a talent show), Prom
- Benefits for Members: Personal and engaging community, opportunities to head and organize projects, enhanced connections with the school administration and student groups

What is Leadership Class?

- Required part of being a Student Council member
- Semester long morning class with school credit to teach leadership theory and applications

When is Student Council?

- Student Council is primarily a morning time commitment
- Student Council meets Mondays & Tuesdays
- Leadership class, which lasts from the start of the school year until the end of first semester, is every Thursday & Friday.
- Both Student Council and Leadership class run from 7:15 to 8:00 am
- Wednesday mornings are used for committee work time
- Student Council expects its members to attend all required events and the majority of voluntary events (however, we do work with conflicts, including band, when Though this may seem like a large time commitment, keep in mind that your fellow council members will become good friends and that this is a rewarding activity

How Do I Apply?

- In order to maximize interactions between members, increase productivity, and create a good environment, the LSW Student Council has a limit of 25 students (with members from a variety of grades); consequently, applications -are needed to see who can best help Student Council and who Student Council can help best
